

SHAW Winemakers Selection 2019 Riesling

Tasting Notes

A wonderful nose of lime blossom with dried floral notes. A lively palate of fresh limes and mouth watering acidity with a soft delicate finish.

Winemaking and Viticulture

Riesling is an aromatic grape variety displaying flowery, almost perfumed aromas as well as high acidity. This classic dry Riesling shows all these attributes. Much of the unique character of this wine is developed in the vineyard, low yielding spur-pruned vines with fruit harvested in the cool of the night to ensure fruit is delivered at temperatures less than 20 degrees. All the fruit is sourced solely from Shaw Vineyard Estate's Murrumbateman vineyard, an area renowned for production of premium cool climate wines Stelvin closures are used for freshness and to ensure long-term quality.
